
Republic Day

Republic day is celebrated on 26th January every year in India. The Constitution formally came into force on this day in the year 1950.


It is one of the three national festivals of India.





Where is the Amar Jawan Jyoti located now?

Amar Jawan Jyoti is now located at the inner ring, the Amar Chakra, of National War Memorial. The Memorial has four concentric circles and a central obelisk, at the bottom of which burns an 'eternal flame' representing the immortal soldier.
